Recycling Information

Dorr Township residents are eligible for curbside recycling service, sign up by contacting Dorr Township at (616) 681-9874 ext 105

- Residents may contact Arrowaste at (616) 748-1955, to report a missed pickup.

What to recycle

- Cardboard & Paper board
- Magazines, newsprint, paper, & junk mail
- Cartons
- Glass bottles & jars
- Plastic containers #1-7
- Metal cans, pie plates, & foil



- Empty containers
- Rinse & dry containers
- Leave the caps on
- Flatten cardboard boxes
- Respect the recycling station & property



- No food or soiled items
- No hazardous materials
- No large plastic items
- No clothes
- No plastic bags
- No styrofoam



Obey the guidelines!

Contaminated recycling ends up in landfills and increases overall recycling costs.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Batteries, oil based paints, pesticides, solvents, fluorescent bulbs, cleaners, sharps and other chemicals can be dropped off by appointment at the Health Department.

Medication Disposal

Unwanted medications can be dropped off at the following law enforcement stations:
